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The Current Government Decisions for Economic Development of the Russian Far East: a Critical View

The article is devoted to the critical view of the current decisions the government of Russia in relation to the Far Eastern region economic development: the implementation of federal special-purpose programs; priority social and economic development areas & the free port of Vladivostok creating; free provision of land parcels (i.e. Far Eastern hectare). The economic and institutional characteristics of the Russian Far East economic development have been analyzed. The possible effectiveness of the current decisions concerning the Russian Far East economic development through the lens of experience of other countries with high natural resources rents in economy has been estimated. The author shows that government decisions only helped to accelerate the development of the regions in the case of one's integrated into the overall policy to reduce risks in the domestic economy.

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Ownerless Roads in Russia

The article is dedicated to ownerless road as a complex management, legal and economic problem. Current judicial and administrative practice traces only the local cases of ownerlessness, but it seems to be widescale, significant and systematic phenomenon. The analysis is based on scientific literature and legislation review, statistics and local mass media investigation. Illegitimate roads and its scale do not correlate with administrative-territorial, geographic or regional economic factors. Ownerlessness was triggered by long-term existence of demotivating system of road financing, by complexity of procedures and unresolved land relations in Russia.

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National Diversity in Russian Regions

Estimations of the national diversity for the whole Russia and for the regions are obtained based on the census data for 2002 and 2010. Indexes of heterogeneity, entropy and polarization are used as well as distributional functions and summary statistics of the ethnic heterogeneity. The results show: 1) decrease of the ethnic diversity in the whole country; 2) significant interregional differences both in the dynamics and in the levels of the national heterogeneity; 3) essential differences in the polarization of the national structure of the population between the subjects of RF.
